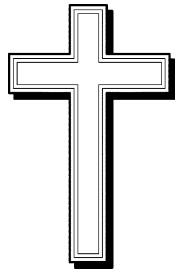

**Sacramental Schedule**

Reconciliation – Saturday at 5:30 PM in Phillipsburg, Sunday Morning prior to Mass in Logan; or contact the priest to set up an appointment for confession.

Marriage – contact the priest at least six months prior to the wedding date to complete required marriage preparation.

Anointing of the Sick – contact the priest to schedule a time to be anointed.

If you are admitted to the hospital, please ask the hospital or a family member to contact the priest so that he may come to visit you, or if you are homebound.

**Fast and Abstinence for Lent:**

- A. Every one 14 yrs of age and older is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent including Good Friday.
- B. Every one 18 yrs. of age or older and under 60 yrs. of age is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
- C. On these two days of Fast and Abstinence only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal one full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted on these two days, liquids, including milk and fruit juice are allowed. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.
- D. To disregard completely the law of Fast and Abstinence is a serious matter.
- E. Going to Mass every Sunday and if possible attending weekday Mass, doing acts of charity, forgiveness, and good deeds of virtue are obligations of daily life of Catholics especially during Lent.

## Novena for Protection and Healing from abuse

### Intercessions:

Day 1: May the most vulnerable be protected from all types of abuse and exploitation.

Day 2: May those who have been sexually abused receive comfort and healing.

Day 3: May those who work with children and young people be vigilant in protecting them from harm.

Day 4: May those who provide help for the abused act with wisdom and compassion in their healing ministries.

Day 5: May all families strive to provide safe and nurturing environment for children and young people.

Day 6: May all those who have committed abuse acknowledge the harm they have done, repent, and accept justice that ultimately comes from God.

Day 7: May those who have been abused receive the courage to tell their story, and may they be believed and supported.

Day 8: May Church leaders, with the guidance of the Holy Spirit, promote justice and healing for survivors of abuse.

Day 9: May our Holy Father, Pope Francis, fulfill his role as good shepherd and protect the most vulnerable in his flock.

Prayers: 1 Our Father, 3 Hail Mary's, Glory be, Prayer for healing.

### Prayer for healing:

God of endless love, ever caring, ever strong, always present, always just: You gave your only Son to save us by the blood of his Cross. Gentle Jesus, shepherd of peace, join to your own suffering the pain of all who have been hurt in body, mind, and spirit by those who betrayed the trust placed in them. Hear our cries as we agonize over the harm done to our brothers and sisters. Breathe wisdom into

our prayers, soothe restless hearts with hope, steady shaken spirits with faith. Show us the way to justice and wholeness, enlightened by truth and enfolded in your mercy. Holy Spirit comforter of hearts, heal your people's wounds and transform our brokenness. Grant us courage and wisdom, humility and grace so that we may act with justice and find peace in you. We ask this through Christ, our Lord. Amen.

### Report Abuse: Message from Bishop Vincke

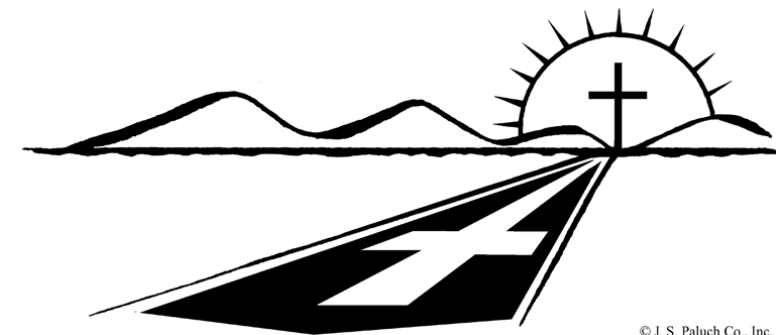
