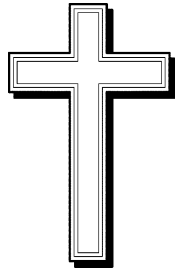

Sacramental Schedule

Reconciliation – Saturday prior to Mass in Phillipsburg, Sunday Morning prior to Mass in Logan; or contact the priest to set up an appointment for confession.
Baptism – contact the priest to schedule. Instructions required with the first child.
Marriage–contact the priest at least six months prior to the wedding date to complete required marriage preparation.

Anointing of the Sick – contact the priest to schedule a time to be anointed.
If you are admitted to the hospital, please ask the hospital or a family member to contact the priest so that he may come to visit you, or if you are homebound.

Three in One: Father, Son and the Holy Spirit

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Many people ask, “How can God be three and yet one?” Even great saints struggled to explain this mystery fully. St. Augustine once said that trying to understand the Trinity completely is like trying to pour the entire ocean into a small hole in the sand. The mystery is greater than our minds.

Today’s Gospel Jesus says: “For God so loved the world that He gave His only Son.” This is the heart of the Trinity: The **Father** creates and gives life. The **Son** redeems and saves. The **Holy Spirit** sanctifies and strengthens. Trinity is a communion of perfect love, in which we are created as his own.

Every time we begin Mass with the Sign of the Cross, we proclaim this mystery:

The Sign of the Cross is not merely a ritual gesture. It is a declaration of who we belong to. From Baptism onward, we are immersed into the life of the Trinity.

Our world today suffers from loneliness, broken relationships, and division. This feast reminds us that we are made for relationship with God and with one another. If God is communion, then Christians must become people of communion. A true life is found not in isolation, but in self-giving love. In families, there must be forgiveness and unity. In parishes, there must be cooperation instead of division. In society, there must be respect and compassion. A person cannot claim to love the Triune God while living with hatred, pride, or selfishness but by reflecting God’s love in daily life.
