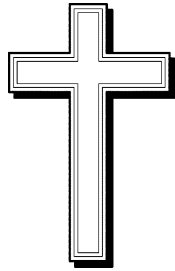

**Sacramental Schedule**

Reconciliation – Saturday prior to Mass in Phillipsburg, Sunday Morning prior to Mass in Logan; or contact the priest to set up an appointment for confession.  
Baptism – contact the priest to schedule. Instructions required with the first child.  
Marriage–contact the priest at least six months prior to the wedding date to complete required marriage preparation.

Anointing of the Sick – contact the priest to schedule a time to be anointed.

## Every Act of love is big in the eyes of God

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Today's Gospel presents us with some of the most challenging words of Jesus: "Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me." How to understand these words of Jesus?

When God occupies the first place, every other relationship finds its proper place. He wants to insist that when anything-even something good such as family, work, money, or reputation-takes the place of God; our lives become disordered.

In the first reading, we meet a generous woman who welcomes Elisha, a holy man of God; without expecting any reward. God blesses her with the gift of a son. When we welcome God's presence into our lives, blessings and rewards follow us without fail.

At the end of the Gospel, Jesus says:

"Whoever gives only a cup of cold water to one of these little ones because he is a disciple will surely not lose his reward." How beautiful! Jesus notices even the smallest act of kindness. Many people think holiness requires extraordinary deeds. But often holiness is found in ordinary acts: a kind word to someone who is lonely, helping a neighbor, visiting the sick, praying for someone in need, welcoming a stranger, offering encouragement to a discouraged person. No act of love is too small in God's eyes.

When we put Christ first, we do not lose anything of real value. Instead, we discover the fullness of life, joy, and peace that only He can give.
